KEY STAGE 2

When children move into Year 3 they join KS2. In all the years from Year 3 to Year 6 there are three mixed ability classes, of 30 children.

The children are taught a varied and creative curriculum where staff plan and deliver lessons which make good use of cross-curricular activities and help children to develop an enjoyment of learning.

Year 5 and Year 6 are set for mathematics and Year 6 is also set for literacy, however, both subjects are also incorporated into other curriculum subjects taught in class groups.

All curriculum areas are planned across year groups and key stages for continuity and progression.

Each term a trip, a specialist visitor or workshop is organised for each year group, to help bring their learning to life. Year 5 and Year 6 have the opportunity to take part in residential trips, one linked to their topic work and the other at a PGL activity centre.

The children present assemblies with focus on their current learning and these are performed to the pupils, parents, governors and family.
