<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A timetable of work will be provided. This will be emailed, text and saved on J2e. • The timetable will provide you with details of live sessions which will take place through the week. • We will aim to complete at least 2 daily live sessions linked to core subjects. • These will take place in the morning as children will also have the opportunity to link in live to lessons taking place in school. This will ensure all pupils, whether at home or school are provided with the same learning materials. • The link to teams will be made available through J2e and pupils are using this in school for practise. • A letter detailing this information will be sent to parents/carers. • Paper packs will be made available for the duration of the closure and parents/carers will be text times and days for collection. • Additional work will be uploaded to J2e for pupils to complete. Teachers will provide feedback to pupils throughout the week. • A weekly well being phone call will be made. • Well being videos for pupils will be shared. • Where possible, small group sessions will be delivered. Parent/carers will be notified of timings via text message. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teachers will be set up with the equipment they need to be able to teach their class from home throughout the day. • They are expected to maintain professional at all times and be mindful of their background etc. • Teachers will make a wellbeing call to each child • If there are children from the other class isolating they will also teach and mark their work. • An additional member of staff will be in the classroom to support the learning. • Feedback will still be provided to pupils in order to develop their learning. Verbal and online • The senior leader working with the year group will check in with the class on a daily basis. • Additional pastoral support will be provided. • Teachers will be available during the working hours for meetings and will continue with staff CPD. • Teachers will record foundation lessons videos explaining the subject and task. • Teachers will be responsible for preparing the paper packs and sending them to the school office to print and ensure they know when the packs can be collected by parents. • Monitor the children who access the live sessions by keeping a register. • Share any safeguarding concerns with DSL
