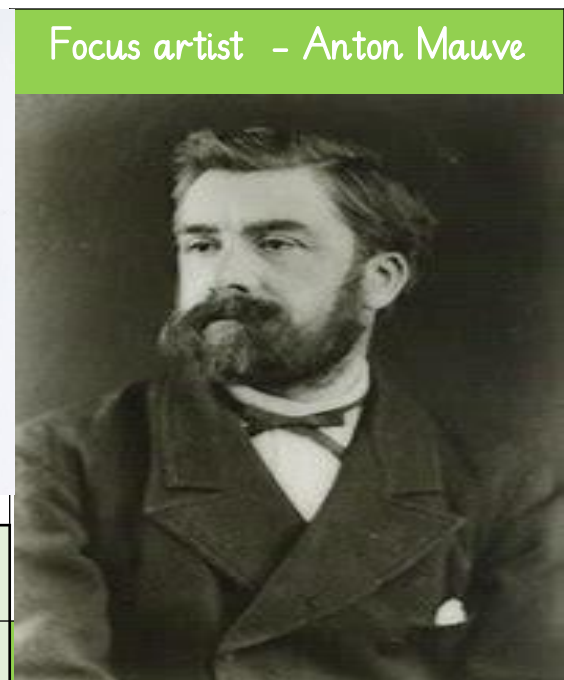


## Year 2 Art and Design knowledge map – drawing and painting

Subject Specific Vocabulary	
<b>study</b>	spending time and attention on gaining knowledge of a subject
<b>similarities</b>	ways that something is like another thing.
<b>Differences</b>	point or way in which people or things are dissimilar
<b>effect</b>	cause (something) to happen; bring about.
<b>muted</b>	muted - (of colour or lighting) not bright; subdued.
<b>plough</b>	plough - turn up the earth of (an area of land) with a plough, especially before sowing.
<b>shading</b>	shading - the darkening or colouring of an illustration or diagram with parallel lines or a block of colour.  "scenes can be given perspective by colour and shading"

Anthonij (Anton) Rudolf Mauve (18 September 1838 – 5 February 1888) was a Dutch realist painter who was a leading member of the Hague School. A master colourist, he was a very significant early influence on his cousin-in-law Vincent van Gogh.

Vincent Van Gogh was a Dutch post-impressionist painter, famous for his landscape, portrait and self –portrait painting.
